GUIDELINES FOR FASTING AND

ABSTINENCE Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14-59 years of age. During Lent, the Church encourages attendance at daily Mass, if possible, and self-imposed times of fasting, almsgiving, and works of charity. If you have a medical condition that precludes you from fasting, that is okay.
