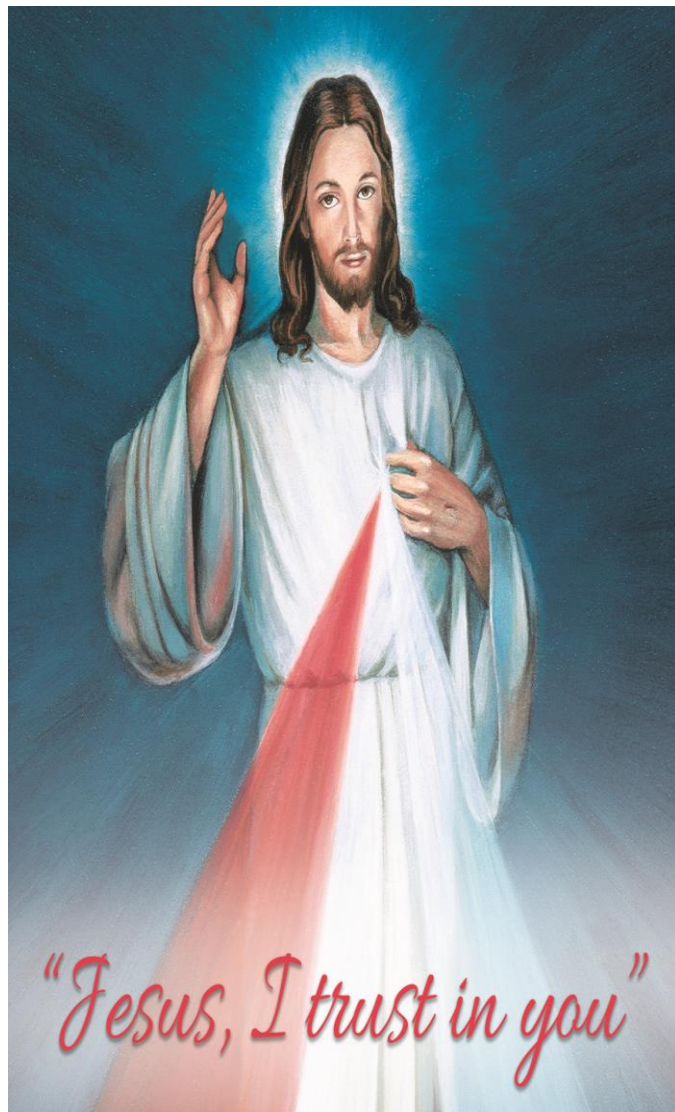

According to the diary, Jesus made the following statements about this day: "On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the font of my mercy. The soul that goes to confession and receives Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are open.
